## ALL ELEMENTARY STUDENTS WILL BE ATTENDING TOGETHER

Although various COVID-19 restrictions have changed in Alberta, PBOE <u>will continue</u> with its masking and isolation mandates for PNSS/NPES schools and all PBOE buses.

**DO NOT** send your child to school if they are showing <u>ANY</u> symptoms of illness. Your child will be sent home if they show symptoms of <u>ANY</u> illness at school or on the bus.

DO NOT send your child to school if you, the child or anyone living in the same home are waiting for the results of a COVID-19 test.

**RUNNY NOSE, CONGESTION, COUGH, SORE THROAT, FEVER, CHILLS & HEADACHE are symptoms of illness school staff will watch for in students.** 

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Rapid Test Kits will be distributed to students on February 14, 2022. If you did not receive your 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> kit, please contact your child's homeroom teacher.

Be advised:

IF a COVID-19 outbreak occurs in the school, in your child's classroom, or on the bus, it could result in closures:

- School Closure Significant #of staff and significant #of students
- Classroom Closure Teacher unable to be in classroom; students would return to on-line learning.
- Bus Closure Bus Driver unable to drive bus; students would return to on-line learning.
